

Wisconsin Parental School Choice Program Requirements for the 2021-2022 School Year

The Wisconsin Parental School Choice Program allows families, who meet the requirements below, with the opportunity of sending their children to a choice school at no cost. Please see requirements below:

- 1) Attendance: A student will need to be entering 9th grade at Liberty Christian School for the 2021-2022 school year OR their attendance in the 2020-2021 school year would need to be at a public school, a current school in the school choice program or homeschooled for the entire year.

- 2) Financial: If a student meets one of the above criteria, then the parents would need to meet the financial qualifications listed below:

Note: 2020-2021 Adjusted Gross Income limits are shown below:

For each additional family member after a family size of 6, add \$9,724 to the Yearly Income.

- 3) Apply: The application process is from Monday, February 1, 2021 through Thursday, April 15, 2021. Please provide the school office with 1) a bill for a utility, cable or landline phone for proof of residence, and 2) income paperwork such as a copy of your prior year tax return or W2 forms. All documents must be given to the office prior to April 15, 2021.
